

LP GAS: Prevent accidents

SAFE HANDLING for cylinders and tanks

In the case of CYLINDERS:

Keep them away from fire or sparks producing objects



Place them on flat surfaces in well ventilated areas



Protect them from damage caused by vehicle or people



Install using copper pipe



Check fittings and replace them when deteriorated



Never use plastic pipes



For gas tanks, don't allow them to be filled over 80% of their capacity



To move them, you must roll them upright, never drag them



Don't expose them to sunrays



Don't turn them over or lay them flat, they must be upright



They must have a pressure regulator



Don't accept cylinders when they show leak, corrosion, valve damage, a deformed bottom or non-professional repairs



If your tank is over 10 years, have it checked by a specialist



Report gas leaks to 911 or fire department in your area
