Identify the five alert levels when a tropical cyclone approaches our territory





Stay tuned to weather information.





Prune trees that obstruct electrical cables and others dangerous situations.



Protect windows with adhesive tape in cross shape and secure objects that may be thrown away by the wind.



Clean up the roofs, drains, channels, and floor drains. Avoid littering.





Identify the nearest temporary refuge and the route to get over quickly.



Store food, drinking water, and handy emergency supplies.



Keep important documents in plastic bags.
