Useful definitions

Listing (Active) - A property listed on Airbnb. Listings may include entire homes or apartments, private rooms or shared spaces. Active Listings are all listings that appear on the website during a search. Active listings do not necessarily have availability on a particular date or at all. The number of listings does not represent the number of properties- a single host may have multiple listings for separate rooms within their house, or an additional listing for their entire home when they are on holiday.

Entire Home / Apartment Listing - A listing where the Guest can rent the entire home from the host. The host is not present in the home during the Guest's stay.

Private Room Listing - A listing where the Guest can rent a private bedroom within a home. The host may be present in other parts of the home during the Guest's stay, and the Guest may share common spaces like the kitchen, living room, and/or a bathroom with the host.

Shared Room Listing - A listing where the Guest can rent a communal space, such as a shared bedroom or a living room sofabed, within a home. The host may be present in the home during the Guest's stay, and the Guest may share common spaces like the kitchen and/or a bathroom with the host.

Guest: Airbnb community members who stay in Airbnb listings.

Host: Airbnb community members who rent out space on Airbnb.
