## SECURITY



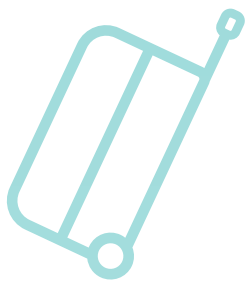
Safety comes first! Please make sure you always lock doors and windows behind you and close and lock all communal doors in our building to ensure security.

## HOUSE RULES



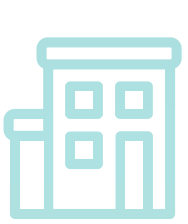

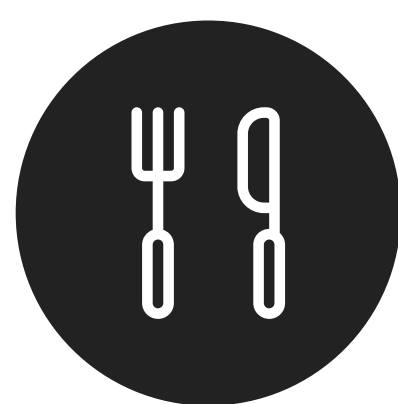

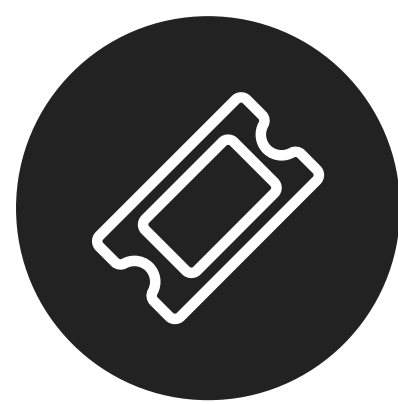
