## FOLLOW THE HOUSE RULES

The grey bin is for non-recyclable and organic waste goes in the brown bin if available). Also respect the common areas and if you happen to meet our neighbours, feel free to say “olá” (hello).

There is much more to Lisbon than the main tourist attractions. Go out and discover local businesses which are part of our cultural heritage, from the tastiest foods such as our famous grilled codfish (bacalhau), to Portuguese Egg Tarts (Pastéis de Belém) or handicraft shops where you can find local products such as Lisbon Historic Shops ([lojascomhistoria.pt](http://lojascomhistoria.pt)). ## RESPECT THE NEIGHBOURHOOD



Lisbon is a lively and lovely city but there are locals who are living and working in the neighbourhood, that's what makes your experience so authentic! Please be mindful of our neighbours and keep your noise down during quiet hours (11.00 pm-7.00 am) and be conscious of the noise of rolling and wheeled suitcases on the street.
