



Museum of Goa, Pilerne: Founded by Subodh Kerkar, it is one of the largest privately-owned contemporary art spaces in Goa, celebrating the state's history and its people. On Sundays, you can even attend lectures by eminent artists, scholars and activists on various topics of interest.


