- 1 Swim at a patrolled beach between the red and yellow flags.
- 2 Know your limits and look out for others.
- 3 Check conditions, including the weather forecast.
- 4 Wear a lifejacket when boating, rock fishing or paddling.
- 5 Always supervise children in, on and around water.
- 6 Avoid alcohol and drugs around water.
